The details:

- Tuesdays at 3 pm at the Kuna library Owl room beginning September 2026. Discuss books with teammates while creating art, molding kinetic sand and building with different styles of blocks or go off to your designated area in the library with your team for the rest of 2025.
- Teams created with up to 4 people per team + 1 alternate.
- As a team, you decide how to read or listen to the books. You can read all 12, you can split them up, etc. No one is required to read a book if they do not want to read it.
- Teams read the books during the fall of 2025, and in Winter 2026 practice battles!
- The questions will be “in which book” (answers below) & “content” questions. Teams have 15 seconds to discuss the answer before the team spokesperson answers.
- The Library Championship battle takes place in Spring 2026 and the Champions compete at regionals 2 weeks later.

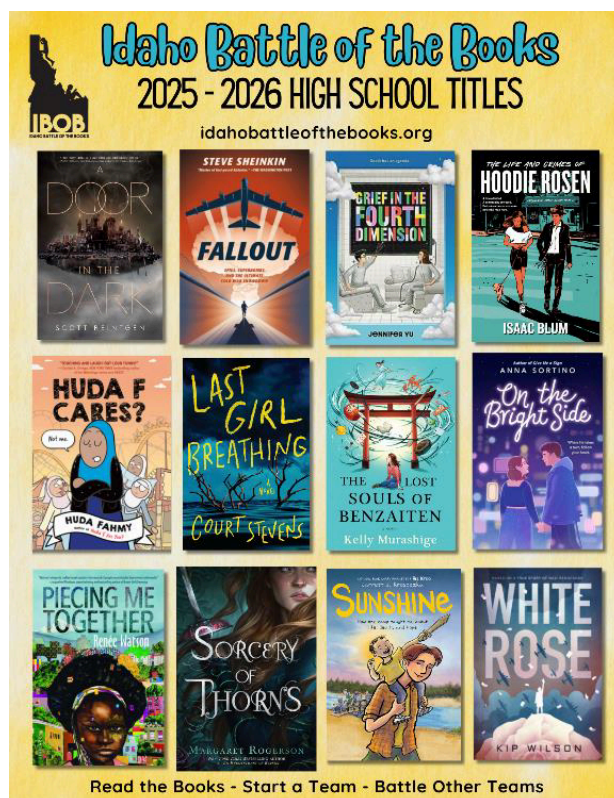

Some of the books may not appeal to everyone because of the genre or content, so work with your team (and parents) to find the books that are right for you.

I understand:

- ☐ I will be on a team with a total of 4 students (and 1 alternate, if we choose). I can choose my own team or be placed on a team.
- ☐ My team will decide how to split up the 12 books and I will do my best to support my team. If a book genre or topic does not work for me, my team and I will discuss strategies.
- ☐ I understand that I will be battling against teams from grades 9-12.
- ☐ I will try to attend all team meetings and any library IBOB activities. I will be an active member of my team.
- ☐ I will be prompt about bringing back the book that was loaned to me.
- ☐ If my team scores high enough, I will attend the Kuna Library district competition held in spring 2026.
- ☐ If my team scores high enough in the library district competition, we will be invited to compete in the regional battle, two weeks later.
- ☐ I will treat my fellow team members and other IBOB participants with respect.
